**Know all Men by these Presents, That Eli Denney & Cynthia
Denny his wife** of Madison County and State of Iowa — in consideration of the sum of One hundred and fifty seven ¹⁰⁰ Dollars, in hand paid, by Benjamin F. Hartsook of Madison County, and State of Iowa do hereby **Sell and Convey**, unto the said Benjamin F. Hartsook in the following described premises, situate in the County of Madison, and State of Iowa, to-wit:

Beginning at a Stake 40 Rods North of the South East corner of Section Thirty two (32), thence West One hundred and Twenty Rods, thence North Twenty six & two thirds Rods, thence East One hundred & twenty Rods, thence South Twenty six and two thirds Rods to the place of beginning containing Twenty Acres, in Township (74) North; of Range No. Twenty nine (29) W. 5th P.M. Iowa.

And We hereby covenant with the said Benjamin F. Hartsook that We hold said premises by good and perfect title, that We have good, right, and lawful authority, to sell and convey the same: that they are free, and clear of all liens and incumbrances whatsoever. And We covenant to warrant and defend the said premises against the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever; and the said Cynthia Denney hereby relinquishes her right of dower in and to the above described premises.
