Daniel Hazen of Madison County, and State of  
Iowa do hereby **Sell and Convey**, unto the said Daniel Hazen

the following described premises, situate in the County of Madison, and State of Iowa, to-wit:  
The South West quarter of Section N<sup>o</sup> Twenty two (22)  
in Township N<sup>o</sup> Seventy seven (77) North; of Range  
N<sup>o</sup> Twenty seven (27) West of the 5<sup>th</sup> P.M. Iowa.  
Containing One Hundred and Sixty Acres more
