County and State of Illinois, do hereby sell and convey unto the said  
John Jones the following described premises, situated in the County of  
Madison and State of Iowa, to-wit; North East  $\frac{1}{4}$  of South West  $\frac{1}{4}$   
& South East  $\frac{1}{4}$  of North West  $\frac{1}{4}$ , & North West  $\frac{1}{4}$  of South East  $\frac{1}{4}$   
& South three fourths ( $\frac{3}{4}$ ) of South West  $\frac{1}{4}$  of North East  $\frac{1}{4}$  and West  
half ( $\frac{1}{2}$ ) of North East  $\frac{1}{4}$  of North West  $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section No Twelve (12)  
Township No Seventy five (75) Range Twenty seven (27), and North  $\frac{1}{4}$  of  
of South West  $\frac{1}{4}$  of South East  $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section No One (1) Township No  
Seventy five (75) Range No Twenty seven (27), & North half  $\frac{1}{2}$  of South East
