Lothrop of Madison County and State of Iowa do hereby sell and convey unto the said L. B. Lothrop the following described premises situated in the County of Madison and State of Iowa to wit: Lot No five (5) in Block No four (4) in the original town plat of the City of Winterset Madison County state of Iowa. and we hereby covenant with the said L. B. Lothrop that we hold said premises by title in fee simple; that we have good right and lawful authority to sell and convey the same; that they are free and clear of all liens and incumbrances whatsoever, and we covenant to warrant and defend the said premises against the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever and the said Rachel Youngman hereby relinquishes her right of Dower in and to the above described premises.
