Ingle & Sarah Ingle his wife of Jasper County, State of Iowa in consideration of the sum of One Thousand (\$1000⁰⁰) Dollars, in hand paid, do hereby sell and convey unto Thomas F. Tuttle of Jasper County, and State of Iowa the following described premises, to-wit; The North West fractional quarter of the North West quarter, and the South fractional half of the North West quarter & the South West quarter of the North East quarter, also the West half of the North East quarter of the North West quarter in Section No Thirty (30) Township No Seventy four (74) Range No Twenty Nine (29) Containing One Hundred & Seventy Six ³/₁₀₀ (176 ³/₁₀₀) Acres more or less. Madison Co. Iowa, and we do hereby covenant with the said Thomas F. Tuttle that we are lawfully seized, in fee simple, of said premises that they are free from incumbrance, that we have good right and lawful authority to sell the same, and we do hereby covenant to warrant and defend the said premises and appurtenances thereto belonging against the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever; and the said Sarah Ingle hereby relinquishes all her right of dower in and to the above described premises.
