Know all Men by these presents, that we Noah Sulgrove and Barbara Sulgrove his wife, of Madison County and State of Iowa, in consideration of the sum of Sixty five dollars, in hand paid, do hereby sell and convey unto B. H. Reynolds of Madison County and State of Iowa, the following described premises, to-wit; Commencing at the South East corner of the North East gr. of the North East gr. of Sec. N^o Fifteen (15) Township N^o Seventy six (76) North of Range N^o Twenty eight (28) West of the 5th P.M. Iowa, running thence North Twenty (20) rods, thence West Twenty (20) rods, thence South Forty (40) rods, thence East Twenty (20) rods, thence North Twenty (20) rods to the place of beginning, Containing five Acres more or less, and we do hereby covenant with the said B. H. Reynolds that we are lawfully seized, in fee simple, of said premises, that they are free from incumbrance, that we have good right and lawful authority to sell the same, and we do hereby covenant to warrant and defend the said premises, and appurtenances thereto belonging, against the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever; and the said Barbara Sulgrove hereby relinquishes all her right of dower in and to the above described premises, Signed the 26th day of December A.D. 1862
