Miller the following described real estate to wit: situated in the County of Madison and State of Iowa Described as follows the East half of the North East quarter of Section Ten (10) in Township Seventy Seven (77) of Range Twenty nine (29) West and we do bind ourselves our heirs and assigns to warrant the title against the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever as witness our hands this thirtieth day of March A.D. 1863
