 Iowa do hereby **Sell and Convey**, unto the said Ashford Lake

the following described premises, situate in the County of Madison, and State of Iowa, to-wit:

The North fractional half of the North West quarter of
 Section No Six (6) - and also enough off of the West side
 of the North West fractional quarter of the North East quarter
 of Section No Six (6) all in Township No Seventy four (74) North; of
 Range Twenty seven (27) West, to make one hundred Acres.

And We hereby covenant with the said Ashford Lake
 that We hold said premises by good
 and perfect title, that _____ have good, right, and lawful authority, to sell and convey the same: that
