**Know all Men by these Presents,** That We Hogan Queen  
and Martha Ann Queen  
of Madison County and State of Iowa in consideration of the sum of  
Thirty Dollars, in hand paid, by  
James Collins of Madison County, and State of  
Iowa do hereby **Sell and Convey,** unto the said James Collins

the following described premises, situate in the County of Madison, and State of Iowa, to-wit:  
 A part of the South West fractional quarter of Section No  
 (18) Eighteen Township No (75) Seventy five, Range No (26)  
 Twenty six. Commencing at the South East corner of said  
 quarter section. Thence North to Jones' Creek, thence with the  
 Meanderings of said Creek to the South line of said South  
 West quarter, thence East with the section line to the place  
 of beginning, containing (6) six acres more or less.

And We hereby covenant with the said James Collins  
 that We hold said premises by good  
 and perfect title, that We have good, right, and lawful authority, to sell and convey the same: that  
 they are free, and clear of all liens and incumbrances whatsoever. And We covenant to warrant  
 and defend the said premises against the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever; and the said  
Martha Ann Queen hereby relinquishes her right of dower in and to the above  
 described premises.
