Know all Men by these Presents, That We David Bradshaw and Mary Bradshaw his wife — of Madison County and State of Iowa — in consideration of the sum of Two hundred and thirty five ¹⁰⁰ Dollars, in hand paid, by J. J. Young — of Madison County, and State of Iowa — do hereby Sell and Convey, unto the said J. J. Young —

the following described premises, situate in the County of Madison, and State of Iowa, to-wit:

The N. W. fourth ($\frac{1}{4}$) of the S. W. quarter, Section Fourteen (14) in Township Seventy four (74) North; of Range Twenty six West, except one half acre in the South est corner of the above named land running so as to encompass, ^{the Grapes} that is there now, containing Thirty nine and one half acres more or less, all situated in County of Madison and State of Iowa.

And We hereby covenant with the said J. J. Young — that We hold said premises by good and perfect title, that We have good, right, and lawful authority, to sell and convey the same: that they are free, and clear of all liens and incumbrances whatsoever.
