Know all Men by these presents, that we John Hillen
& Sarah Hillen of Madison County, State of Iowa,
in consideration of the sum of Two hundred &
fifty dollars, in hand paid, do hereby sell and con-
vey unto James Collins of Madison County and State of Iowa, the following
described premises, to-wit; The South half of the West half of the South
East quarter of Section (18) Eighteen, Township N^o(75) Seventy ~~four~~, Range
(26) Twenty six, Containing forty Acres more or less. And we do hereby
covenant to warrant and defend the said premises against the lawful
claims of all persons whomsoever; and the said Sarah Hillen wife of
the said John Hillen, hereby relinquishes all her right of dower in and
to the above described premises. Signed this 16th day of November A.D 1863.

The word "four" was changed to
