Freeborn & Martha Freeborn of the County of Madison & State of Iowa in consideration of the sum of two hundred dollars in hand paid do hereby sell and convey unto Thomas Garlinger of Madison County Iowa the following described premises to wit, Twenty acres on the South West-Quarter of the South East-Quarter Bounded as follows. Commencing twenty rods North of the South West corner of the South East-Quarter of section thirty four (34) in Township No. Seventy Six (76) North of Range Twenty Six West-Iowa, and running forty rods North on the line of the quarter section thence ~~East~~ Eighty rods East parallel with section line thence forty rods South. thence Eighty rods west to the place of starting containing Twenty acres, and we do hereby warrant and defend the said premises against the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever.
