Know all Men by these Presents, That O. J. McLaughlin and Mintie A. McLaughlin wife of said O. J. McLaughlin of Madison County and State of Iowa in consideration of the sum of Five Hundred & fifty Dollars, in hand paid, by W. R. Danforth of Madison County, and State of Iowa do hereby Sell and Convey, unto the said W. R. Danforth

the following described premises, situate in the County of Madison, and State of Iowa, to-wit:

Lot No. Six (6) in Block No. Twenty six (26) in the City of Winterset according to the Original Town plat.

And We hereby covenant with the said W. R. Danforth that We hold said premises by good and perfect title, that We have good, right, and lawful authority, to sell and convey the same: that they are free, and clear of all liens and incumbrances whatsoever. And We covenant to warrant and defend the said premises against the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever; and the said Mintie A. McLaughlin hereby relinquishes her right of dower in and to the above described premises.
