Be it remembered that by virtue of special execution to me directed, issued from the District Court of said County and tested the 31st day of May A.D. 1865 in a case wherein Madison County for the use of the School Fund was Plaintiff and J. G. Vawter Elizabeth Vawter Lytle Faurote & L.S. Crandall were Defendants commanding me to levy the same upon the East one half  $\frac{1}{2}$  of Lot No two (2) in Block No. Twenty four (24) in the original town Plat of the City of Winterset Madison County Iowa. to satisfy the judgment interest and costs in the above case and for want of sufficient personal property whereon to levy to satisfy the same I did on the 31st day of May A.D. 1865 levy the said writ of execution upon the following described real estate, together with all the estate, right, title and interest of the said defendants aforesaid in and to the same to wit:

The East one half  $\frac{1}{2}$  of Lot No Two (2) in Block No Twenty four (24) in the original Town Plat of the City of Winterset, Iowa and after having advertised the said property for sale for four consecutive weeks, immediately preceding the day of sale hereinafter mentioned in the Hawkeye Flag a newspaper published in the City of Winterset Iowa and posted up notices of the said sale in three public places in said County of Madison Iowa one of which places being in the same township in which said property is situated and one being on the front door of the office of the Clerk of the District Court in said Madison County the place where the last District Court of said County was held as required by law. I did on the 1st day of July A.D. 1865 between the hours of 9 o'clock A.M and 4 o'clock P.M. of that day, proceed to sell said property at the front door of the Clerk's Office in said County by public outcry to the highest bidder for cash and W. W. M<sup>c</sup> Knight then and there bid for East half Lot No. Two (2) Block No Twenty Four (24) original town Plat in the City of Winterset Iowa the sum of One Thousand Eight Hundred Dollars and the same being the best bid offered and the said W. W. M<sup>c</sup> Knight being the highest and best bidder for said parcel of real estate so offered for sale under said writ I did then and there strike off to the said W. W. M<sup>c</sup> Knight the above described real estate for the sum of One thousand eight hundred Dollars. Now therefore I know ye that I H. C. Carter Sheriff of the County of Madison State of Iowa by virtue of the said writ of execution and of the statutes in such cases made and provided and in consideration of the sum of \$1800 Dollars to me in hand paid the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have granted, sold and conveyed, and by these presents do Grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said W. W. M<sup>c</sup> Knight all of the estate right, title and interest which the said J. G. Vawter & Elizabeth Vawter had on the 13th day of July A.D. 1858 or at any time afterwards, or now have in and to all the above mentioned property to have and to hold the same unto the said W. W. M<sup>c</sup> Knight forever as fully as I the said H. C. Carter Sheriff aforesaid and
