Iowa containing forty-five acres more or less. and we do hereby covenant to warrant and defend the said premises against the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever, and the said Rebecca M<sup>c</sup> Ginnis hereby relinquishes all her right of Dower in and to the above described premises.
