Know all Men by these Presents, That We, Patrick Duffy and Margaret wife of the said Patrick Duffy — of Madison County and State of Iowa — in consideration of the sum of One hundred and Twenty ¹⁰⁰ Dollars, in hand paid, by Michael Duffy — of Madison County, and State of Iowa do hereby **Sell and Convey**, unto the said Michael Duffy

the following described premises, situate in the County of Madison, and State of Iowa, to-wit: The South East quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of the North East quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of Section number Sixteen (16) in Township number Seventy seven (77) North; of Range number Twenty six (26) West of ^{5th P. M. And also so much of the South West quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of the said North East quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of said Section, Township and Range as lies East of a middle of a ditch running North and South through the East part of the same, supposed to be about Ten (10) acres.}

And We hereby covenant with the said Michael Duffy — that We hold said premises by good and perfect title, that We have good, right, and lawful authority, to sell and convey the same: that they are free, and clear of all liens and incumbrances whatsoever. And We covenant to warrant and defend the said premises against the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever; and the said Margaret Duffy hereby relinquishes her right of dower in and to the above described premises.
