Know all Men by these Presents, That We Mary Ann Bowsby and William Bowsby husband & wife of Madison County and State of Iowa in consideration of the sum of One Thousand Dollars, in hand paid, by Benjamin F. Bowsby of Madison County, and State of Iowa do hereby **Sell and Convey**, unto the said Benjamin F. Bowsby the following described premises, situate in the County of Madison, and State of Iowa, to-wit:

The West half of the North East quarter (1/4) of Section number Twenty nine (29) in Township number Seventy five (75) North; of Range number Twenty seven (27) West of the 5th Principal Meridian.

And We hereby covenant with the said Benjamin F. Bowsby that We hold said premises by good and perfect title, that We have good, right, and lawful authority, to sell and convey the same: that they are free, and clear of all liens and incumbrances whatsoever. And We covenant to warrant and defend the said premises against the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever; and the said William Bowsby hereby relinquishes his right of dower in and to the above described premises.
