Barns Administrator for the use of the Estate of John Spray, of Warren County, and State of Iowa, the following described premises situated in the county of Madison and State of Iowa, to-wit; The Undivided two thirds of the North West quarter, and the West half of the North East quarter, and the West half of the South West quarter, and the North East quarter of the South West quarter of Section Twenty five (25) in Township seventy seven (77) North of Range Twenty nine (29) West of the 5th P. M. Iowa. and we hereby covenant with the said Thomas G. Barns Administrator that we are lawfully seized, in fee simple, of said premises that they are free from Incumbrance, that we have good right and lawful authority to sell the same, and we do hereby covenant to warrant and defend the said premises and appurtenances thereto belonging against the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever; and the said Fannie A.
