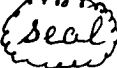

This Indenture, made this Fourth day August in the year of our Lord One thousand Eight hundred and Sixty Four, between Richard Allen and Mary E. Allen his wife of the County of Champaign and State of Illinois, of the first part, and Samuel A. Harvey of the County of Champaign and State of Illinois, of the second part, Witnesseth; That the said party of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of Twelve hundred dollars to them paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do grant bargain, sell, convey and confirm unto the said party of the second part, and to his heirs and assigns, that certain tract or parcel of land, with the appurtenances, lying and being in the County of Madison, and State of Iowa, described as follows, to-wit: The South East quarter of the South West quarter of Section No Seven (7), and the North half of the South East quarter of Section Twenty one (21) all in Township No Seventy five (75) North of Range No Twenty nine (29) West of the 5th Principal Meridian. To have and to hold the aforesaid granted premises, to the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns, to him and their use and behoof forever. And the said party of the first part, do hereby for themselves and their heirs, executors and administrators, covenant with the said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns, that they are lawfully seized, in fee simple, of the aforesaid premises; that they are free from all incumbrances; that they have good right to sell and convey the same to the said party of the second part; and that they and their heirs, executors and administrators will warrant and defend the said tract or parcel of land, to the said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns forever, against the lawful claims and demands of all persons.
