unto the said James Carroll, the following described premises, situated in  
the County of Madison and State of Iowa, to-wit; The South West quarter  
of South West quarter of Section No Four (4) And also the Undivided One  
half of the East half of the South West quarter of Section No Four (4) all  
in Township No Seventy six (76) North of Range No Twenty six (26) West of 5<sup>th</sup>  
P.M. Iowa, and we hereby covenant with the said James Carroll that we hold  
said premises by title in fee simple; that we have a good right and lawful au-  
thority to sell ~~and~~ convey the same; that they are free and clear of all liens and in-  
cumbrances whatsoever, and we covenant to warrant and defend the said prem-  
ises against the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever; and the said Margaret  
McGighe hereby relinquishes her right of dower in and to the above described premises,
