West Quarter of the South West quarter of Section No. Four (4), and the South
East quarter of the South East quarter of Section No. Five (5), and North East
quarter of the North East quarter of Section No. Eight (8) all in Township No.
Seventy six (76) North of Range No. Twenty six (26) West of the 5th P. M. Iowa.
And the said Margaret McTighe hereby relinquishes all her right of dower in and
to the above described premises. Signed this 21st day of December A.D. 1864
