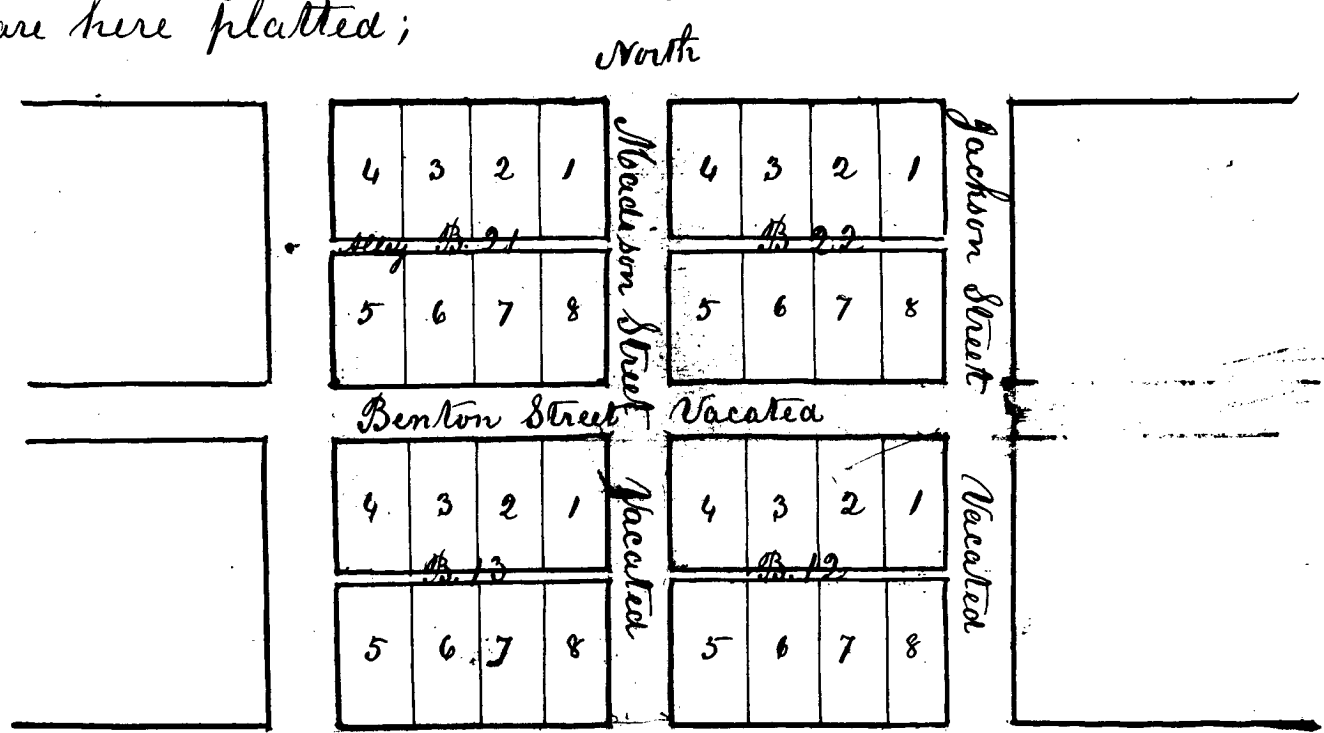

John A. Pitzer
 Allieys in
 Knights Add.
 to Winterset

Know all men by these presents, that I, John A. Pitzer of the County of Madison, in the State of Iowa, heretofore a Court; June 1856 did in connection with one Addison Knight cause to be surveyed, Platted and Recorded a certain Addition to the City of Winterset in the County of Madison, in the State of Iowa, known and distinguished upon the plat of said City of Winterset, and upon the deed records of said County of Madison in the State of Iowa, as "Pitzer and Knights Addition" to the City of Winterset Iowa, Now therefore I the said John A. Pitzer have revoked and by these presents do revoke, vacate and divest all public rights in the Streets, Alleys, Commons and public grounds laid out, platted & described in said plat, of Pitzer & Knights addition, that is to say Blocks Twelve (12) Thirteen (13), Twenty one (21) and Twenty two (22), and also the Street running East & West between Blocks Twelve (12) & Thirteen (13) on the South, and Blocks Twenty one (21) & Twenty two (22) upon the North, said Street is known marked and distinguished upon said plat as Benton Street, And also the Street running North & South between Blocks Twelve (12) and Twenty two (22) on the East, and Blocks Thirteen (13) and Twenty one (21) on the West, said Street is marked, known and distinguished upon said plat as Madison Street, And also the Street running North & South upon the East side of said Blocks Twelve (12) and Twenty two (22) said Street is marked, known and distinguished upon said plat as Jackson Street. And all, each and every alley running through said Blocks Twelve (12) and Twenty two (22) said Street is marked, known and distinguished upon said plat as Jackson Street.

Thirteen (13) Twenty one (21) and Twenty two (22), Said Blocks, Streets, and Alleys so vacated are here platted;



And whereas I the said John A. Pitzer am the owner and seized in fee simple of the title to all of said lots in said Blocks above platted, never having disposed or sold any of the lots in said Blocks, do hereby and by these presents, do revoke, annul and vacate so much of the plat of said Addition of Pitzer & Knights addition to the City of Winterset Iowa, Recorded in Book 'E' pages 147 & 148 as above platted and herein specified. And by these presents do revoke, vacate and divest all public rights in the Streets, Alleys and Blocks as here platted and specified, in & to said Addition of Pitzers & Knights to the City of Winterset, Iowa. In testimony whereof I the said John A. Pitzer have hereunto subscribed my name on this 30th day of July A.D. 1865
