 Iowa do hereby **Sell and Convey**, unto the said John Kirkwood
 the following described premises, situate in the County of Madison, and State of Iowa, to-wit:
 East half of the North East quarter of the North East of the
 North East quarter of Section No Eight (8) Township No
 Seventy five (75) North of Range Twenty seven (27) West, fifth
