Iowa, also the South West quarter of the South East quarter, and the South East quarter of South West quarter and the East half of the South East quarter of Section Number Twenty (20) and the North East quarter of the North East quarter of Section Number Twenty (20) Township Number Seventy five (75) Range 29 West. All in Madison County, and State of Iowa, To have and to hold the above described premises, with all the privileges and appurtenances thereto belonging, to the party of the second part, their heirs and assigns forever, In Testimony whereof, the said party of the first part have hereunto set their hands and seals, the day and year first above written,
