Know all Men by these presents, That we Isaac Gifford and Sarah Gifford of Polk County, State of Iowa, in consideration of the sum of Fourteen hundred and Twenty-five dollars, in hand paid, do hereby sell and convey, unto William Fenamore of Madison County, and State of Iowa, the following described premises to wit; The West half ($\frac{1}{2}$) of the South West quarter of Section Twenty six (26), and the West half ($\frac{1}{2}$) of the East half ($\frac{1}{2}$) of the West half ($\frac{1}{2}$) of the South West quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of Section (23) Twenty-three, And the West ($\frac{1}{2}$) half of the East half ($\frac{1}{2}$) of the North East quarter of the South West quarter of Section Twenty-four (24) all in Township N^o (75) Seventy-five North, Range N^o (27) Twenty-seven West of the 5th P.M. Iowa. And we do hereby covenant to warrant and defend the said premises against the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever; and the said Sarah Gifford wife of the said Isaac Gifford hereby relinquishes all her right of dower in and to the above described premises.
