Whereas Emerson Hazen of Madison County Iowa has deposited in the office of the register of the state land office a certificate of the Clerk of the district court of Madison County Iowa whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said Emerson Hazen according to law for the west half of Section No. fifteen (15) in township No. seventy seven (77) North of range No. twenty six (26) west of the 3rd Principal Meridian being a part of the sixteenth section (16th Sec) grant and containing three hundred and (320) acres according to the official plat of the survey of said land which said tract has been purchased by the said Emerson Hazen Now know ye that the State of Iowa in consideration of the premises and in conformity with the several acts of the General Assembly in such cases made and provided has given and granted and by these presents do give and grant unto the said Emerson Hazen and to his heirs assigns the said tract of land above described to have and to hold the same together with all the rights privileges immunities and appurtenances of whatever nature thereunto belonging unto the said Emerson Hazen and to his heirs and assigns forever in testimony whereof W. M. Stone Governor of the State of Iowa have caused these letters to be made patent and the great Seal of the State of Iowa to be hereunto affixed Given under my hand at Des Moines the nineteenth day of July in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and Sixty five and of the the State of Iowa the nineteenth
