Know all Men by these Presents, That We James McNeley and Jane McNeley his wife of Madison County and State of Iowa in consideration of the sum of One hundred and fifty Dollars, in hand paid, by Solomon J. McNeley of Madison County, and State of Iowa do hereby Sell and Convey, unto the said Solomon J. McNeley

the following described premises, situate in the County of Madison, and State of Iowa, to-wit:

The South East  $\frac{1}{4}$  of the North West quarter of Section No Twenty two (22)

Also commencing at the North East corner of the South East quarter of Section Thirty three (33) thence running South Forty seven 47 Rods and Ten (10) feet, thence West to South River, thence down South River to the East and West line, thence East to the place of beginning, all in Township Seventy four (74) N. of Range Twenty six (26) West all situated in Madison County and State of Iowa, and containing (4.5) acres more or less.

And We hereby covenant with the said Solomon J. McNeley

that We hold said premises by good and perfect title, that We have good, right, and lawful authority, to sell and convey the same: that they are free, and clear of all liens and incumbrances whatsoever. And We covenant to warrant and defend the said premises against the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever; and the said Jane McNeley hereby relinquishes her right of dower in and to the above described premises.
