Sarah Mason, Administratrix of the Estate of Isaac Mason, and in favor  
of R. Moore ~~allowing~~ for the sum of forty four dollars, principal  
interest, and cost each, and is the Sheriff of said County directed after giving  
due and legal notice of the sale of said property hereafter described, the  
same having been levied upon by me, I have sold at public auction at the  
door of the office of the Clerk in the City of Winterset, the County seat of  
Madison County, to the said A. J. Brown the following described Real Estate

Whereas on the 11th day of March 1858, P. Mun. and Thos. Galloway recovered a judgment in the District Court of the County of Madison and State of Iowa against Sarah M. Davis, as Administrator of the Estate of Isaac Mason deceased for the sum of forty four dollars and cents, with interest and costs and on the 21st day of April 1858, the saidiffs caused an execution to be issued on said judgment to J. K. Evans, Sheriff of said County to be levied upon the following Real Estate to wit; the South half of lots No's three and four, in block No. seven, in the original town plat of the City of Winterset, Madison County, and State of Iowa. and on the 22nd day of May 1858, at the door of the office of the Clerk of said Court, I struck off and sold the same at public auction, between the hours of nine o'clock AM, and 4 o'clock PM of said day to A.
