To know all men by these presents; that whereas the Board of Supervisors of Madison County, Iowa, at their September session, A.D. 1865. First, on the 4<sup>th</sup> day of September A.D. 1865, adopted a resolution authorizing the Clerk of said Board, to execute and deliver to F. J. Bash, a quit claim deed quit-claiming to F. J. Bash the land and town property herein after described. Therefore I, M. R. Tidwick, Clerk of the Board of Supervisors for said Madison County, in consideration of the premises herein before mentioned, and the further sum of One Dollar to the said County, in hand paid, do by virtue of said authority so given, hereby release, remise and forever quit claim to said F. J. Bash, all the right, title, and interest of said County of Madison in and to the Middle third of Lot one, in Block Eighteen of the Original Plat of the town of Winterset, in said County.
