**Know all Men by these Presents, That we Henry Taylor and  
Hannah Taylor**

of Madison County and State of Iowa

in consideration of the sum of

One Hundred

Dollars, in hand paid, by

Thomas C. Estep of Madison County, and State of  
Iowa do hereby **Sell and Convey**, unto the said Thomas C. Estep

the following described premises, situate in the County of Madison, and State of Iowa, to-wit:

Commencing on the East side of the North East quarter of the South West quarter of Section Twenty Nine, Township Seventy seven, Range Twenty Eight, near South branch thence taking the meanderings of the bluffs on the top of the bluff so as to leave all the timber on the North side, containing Twenty five acres more or less. Also the East half of the North West quarter of the North West quarter of the same Section, Township and Range.

Nevertheless this conveyance to be void on condition that Henry Taylor shall promptly pay a certain Note of even date herewith calling for the payment by said Henry Taylor to said Thomas C. Estep of One hundred dollars with ten per cent interest one year from date, otherwise to be in full force & virtue

And We hereby covenant with the said Thomas C. Estep his Executors &  
Assigns that We hold said premises by good  
and perfect title, that We have good, right, and lawful authority, to sell and convey the same: that  
they are free, and clear of all liens and incumbrances whatsoever. And We covenant to warrant  
and defend the said premises against the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever, and the said  
Hannah Taylor hereby relinquishes her right of dower in and to the above  
described premises.
