**Know all Men by these Presents, That We Henry B. Stover,  
Martha A. Stephens, and Nathaniel Stephens  
of Madison County and State of Territory of Nebraska in consideration of the sum of  
fifty Twenty Eight &  $\frac{57}{100}$  Dollars, in hand paid, by  
Eli Cox of Madison County, and State of  
Iowa do hereby Sell and Convey, unto the said Eli Cox**

the following described premises, situate in the County of Madison, and State of Iowa, to-wit:

The Undivided  $\frac{2}{7}$  two sevenths part of the East half of the  
East half of the North East quarter of the North West quarter  
of Section number (7) Seven, Township Number (76) Seventy  
six Range number (27) Twenty seven. Containing Ten acres  
more or less.

And We hereby covenant with the said Eli Cox

that We hold said premises by good  
and perfect title, that We have good, right, and lawful authority, to sell and convey the same: that  
they are free, and clear of all liens and incumbrances whatsoever. And We covenant to warrant  
and defend the said premises against the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever; and the said  
Nathaniel Stephens hereby relinquishes her right of dower in and to the above
