To now all men by these presents, that Noah Sulgrave and Barbara Sulgrave his wife, of Madison County, State of Iowa, in consideration of the sum of One Hundred and Twenty-five Dollars in hand paid, do hereby sell and convey, unto Samuel Williams of Madison County, and State of Iowa, the following described premises, to-wit: commencing at the South Street corner of the North East quarter of the North East quarter of Section No. fifteen (15) Township No. Seventy-six (76) North of Range No. Twenty-Eight (28) Street of the 5th P.M. Iowa, running thence North Twenty (20) rods thence East Forty (40) rods, thence South Forty (40) rods, thence West Forty (40) rods, thence North Twenty (20) rods, to the place of beginning, containing 10 acres more or less, and we do hereby covenant with the said Samuel Williams, that we are lawfully seized, in fee-simple, of said premises, that they are free from incumbrance, that we have good right and lawful authority to sell the same, and we do hereby covenant to warrant and defend the said premises and appurtenances thereto belonging, against the lawful claims of all persons whatsoever, and the said Barbara Sulgrave, hereby relinquishes all her right of Dower, in and to the above described premises,
