Know all Men by these Presents, That We John E. Warnock and Sarah Warnock of Madison County and State of Iowa —— in consideration of the sum of Five Hundred ¹⁰⁰ Dollars, in hand paid, by Rice Cooper —— of Washington County, and State of Ohio do hereby Sell and Convey, unto the said Rice Cooper

the following described premises, situate in the County of Madison, and State of Iowa, to-wit:

Twenty five (25) acres off of the East side of the North East quarter of the North West quarter of Section number Twenty six (26) And the South East quarter of the North East quarter of Section number Twenty seven (27) all in Township Number Seventy five (75) Range number Twenty nine (29)

And We hereby covenant with the said Rice Cooper

that We hold said premises by good and perfect title, that We have good, right, and lawful authority, to sell and convey the same: that they are free, and clear of all liens and incumbrances whatsoever. And We covenant to warrant and defend the said premises against the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever: and the said Sarah Warnock hereby relinquishes her right of dower in and to the above described premises.
