



consideration of the sum of One Thous and Dollars, to him in hand paid,  
by the said party of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged  
deth by these presents, grant, bargain, sell and convey, to the said party of the  
second, his heirs and assigns forever, all that tract or parcel of land, lying and  
being in the County of Madison, and State of Iowa, described as follows.  
to-wit: South half of South West quarter, and South West quarter of North  
West quarter, of Section Seventeen (17) Town Seventy-Six (76) Range Twenty-Eight  
(28). Amounting to One hundred and Twenty (120) acres, to have and to hold  
the same, together with all the hereditaments and appurtenances thereto  
belonging, or in any wise appertaining. And the said Henry K. Lee, party of  
the first part, does hereby for him and his heirs, executors, and administrators,  
and each and every of them, covenant and agree to and with the said party of  
the second part, his heirs and assigns, that he is lawfully seized in fee of the  
afore said premises, that they are free from all incumbrances except the taxes  
now due, that he has good right, full power, and lawful authority to sell and  
convey the same, and that he, his heirs, executors and administrators will  
warrant and defend the title to the same forever, against all lawful claims  
except taxes. In testimony whereof the said party of the first part, has here-  
unto set his hand and seal, the day and year first above written.
