and convey, unto Jacob Moarly, of Union County, and State of Iowa, the following described premises, to-wit: The East half of South West quarter, of Section No. Twenty-eight (28), Township Seventy-four (74), North of No. Twenty-nine (29) West, containing Eighty (80) acres, also, the South East fourth of South East quarter of Section Twenty (20), and the North East fourth of North East quarter of Section No. Twenty-nine (29), in Township No. Seventy-four (74), North of Range No. Twenty-nine (29) West, containing Eighty (80) acres, and we do hereby covenant to warrant and defend the said premises against the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever, and the said Mary Barker, hereby relinquishes all her right of dower in and to the above described premises.
