**Know all Men by these Presents, That I E. D. Smith**

of Madison County and State of Iowa ————— in consideration of the sum of  
 Three Hundred <sup>100</sup> Dollars, in hand paid, by  
 Samuel Hamilton of Madison County, and State of  
 Iowa do hereby **Sell and Convey**, unto the said Samuel Hamilton

the following described premises, situate in the County of Madison, and State of Iowa, to-wit:

Twenty two (22) Acres of Land off the South side of the South-West quarter of the South West quarter of Section No Thirty-four Township No Seventy six (76) North, of Range No Twenty seven (27) West of 5<sup>th</sup> P<sup>l</sup> M Iowa.

And I hereby covenant with the said Samuel Hamilton

that I hold said premises by good and perfect title, that I have good, right, and lawful authority, to sell and convey the same: that they are free, and clear of all liens and incumbrances whatsoever. And I covenant to warrant and defend the said premises against the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever; and the said hereby relinquishes her right of dower in and to the above described premises.
