herby sell and convey, unto Robert M^c Dowell, of Madison County, State of Iowa, the following described premises, to-wit: Ten acres more or less out of the South East quarter of the South West quarter of Section Twelve (12) described as follows, commencing Twenty rods East of the North West corner of said quarter, running thence Twenty rods East thence Eighty rods South, thence Twenty rods West, thence ~~Eighty~~ rods North to the place of beginning, in Township No. Seventy-six (76) North of Range No. Twenty-seven (27) West, And we do hereby covenant to warrant and defend the said premises against the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever, and the said Dorinda E. Harris, hereby relinquishes her right of Dower in and to the above described premises.
