of Madison County and State of Iowa in consideration of the sum of Sixty Six ¹⁰⁰ Dollars, in hand paid, by
A. J. Stiffler of Madison County, and State of Iowa do hereby Sell and Convey, unto the said A. J. Stiffler

the following described premises, situate in the County of Madison, and State of Iowa, to-wit:

The one Undivided third part of Lots No. Three (3) and Four (4) in Block Eleven (11) in the Original Town Plat of the City of Winterset, in the aforesaid County and State.

And I hereby covenant with the said A. J. Stiffler that I hold said premises by good and perfect title, that I have good, right, and lawful authority, to sell and convey the same: that they are free, and clear of all liens and incumbrances whatsoever. And I covenant to warrant and defend the said premises against the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever; and the said ~~hardly relinquishes her right of dower in and to the above described premises.~~
