N. Lyte in her capacity of Guardian aforesaid was ordered and empowered to sell said hereinafter described Lands, And Whereas also, The said Guardian has given bond with sureties required by law, And Whereas also, The said Guardian has sold the Real Estate hereinafter described, (being a part of the said Real Estate which the said Guardian was empowered to sell by said of said County Court,) to Esther Ann Brewer and Marion Wilson of Madison County in the State of Iowa for the sum of Three hundred and forty six Dollars. Lyte in my capacity of Guardian as aforesaid, by virtue of the authority vested in me by said County Court, and in pursuance of the said order, of said Court, in consideration of the sum of Three hundred and forty six dollars, to me paid by the said Esther Ann Brewer & Marion Wilson (the receipt whereof I hereby acknowledge,) do by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said Esther Anna Brewer and Marion Wilson and to their heirs and assigns forever, the following described tracts of Real Estate, lying and being situated in the County of Madison and State of Iowa, to-wit; The North West fractional ( $\frac{1}{4}$ ) quarter of Sec. №(31) Thirty one Excepting ten Acres off of the North end of the same, And also (25) Twenty five Acres off of the North side of the South East quarter of the North East quarter of Section № Twenty (20) Excepting ( $\frac{7}{2}$ ) seven and one half acres out of the same, set off as dower to P. N. Lyte for description of see Probate record of said County book B. page (326) all in Township №(75) Seventy five Range №(26) Twenty six. To have and to hold the said described premises unto the said Esther Ann Brewer and Marion Wilson their heirs and assigns forever. And I the said P. N.
