Six hundred <sup>100</sup> Dollars, in hand paid, by

Iowa do hereby **Sell and Convey**, unto the said Hugh Tiams

the following described premises, situate in the County of Madison, and State of Iowa, to-wit:

And the West half of the N.E. quarter of Section Twenty-
