do hereby sell and convey, unto Samuel Hamilton of Madison County and State of Iowa, the following described premises, to wit; Lots three and four (3 & 4) in Block No. Sixteen (16) in original town plat of Winterset, Iowa, and I do hereby covenant with the said Samuel Hamilton, that I am lawfully seized, in fee-simple, of said premises, that they are free from incumbrance, that I have good right and lawful authority to sell the same, and I do hereby covenant to warrant and defend the said premises and appurtenances thereto belonging against the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever. Signed the 4th day of December A.D. 1864.
