 & Administrators Deed, } S. John W. Carp. of the County of Putnam
 William F. Howard. } and State of Indiana. Administrator of
 the Estate of John J. Finley, late of Putnam
 County, Indiana, deceased, intestate, and greeting: Whereas the personal
 Estate of said deceased, was found inadequate to satisfy the
 charges against the said Estate, and application having been made
 for license to sell so much of the Real Estate as would be sufficient
 therefor, after a full statement of all the claims against said
 Estate, and a full account of the disposition of the personal Estate had
 been rendered; and, whereas, by an order of the County judge, of
 said County of Madison, made at a County Court held at Whitewater
 in the said County of Madison, on the 3rd day of October, A.D. 1864, the
 said Administrator was licensed, and empowered to sell and convey
 the Real Estate of the said John J. Finley, herein after described,
 at public or private sale, and whereas, I have caused the said Real
 Estate to be appraised, and the appraisement duly filed according
 to law, and whereas, I, the said Administrator, having complied in
 all respects with the law in such cases required, and with the
 order and direction of the said Madison County Court, did
 on the fourth day of August, A.D. 1865, pursuant to the license afore-
 said, sell at private sale the Real Estate hereinafter described, to
 William F. Howard, of the County of Putnam, for the sum of
 Two Hundred and Forty Dollars. Now therefore, know ye, that
 I, the said John W. Carp. Administrator, by virtue of the power
 and authority in me vested, as aforesaid, and no consideration of
 the sum of Two Hundred and Forty Dollars, the receipt whereof
 is hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant, bargain, sell and
 convey unto the said William F. Howard, his heirs and assigns,
 all that certain tract or parcel of Real Estate, situated in the
 County of Madison, and State of Indiana, to wit: The South $\frac{1}{2}$
 half of the South East quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) and, also, the North West
 quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of the South East quarter of Section Thirty-three (33)
 in Township Twenty-seven (27), North of Range Twenty-nine (29)
 West of P. M. D. R. R. To have and to hold, the above granted
 premises, with all the appurtenances thereto belonging, to the said
 William F. Howard, his heirs and assigns forever. And I,
 the said John W. Carp. as such Administrator, do hereby covenant
 with the said William F. Howard, his heirs and assigns, that
 in conducting said sale, I have complied with all the requirements
 of the Law and of the said Madison County Court.
