Harry Miskimew.

Know all men by these presents, that we, James McCoolly, & Sarah Jane McCoolly, wife of said James McCoolly, of the County of Guernesey, in the State of Ohio for and in consideration of the sum of Three Hundred and Fifty $\frac{5}{10}$ Dollars now in hand paid by Harry Miskimew, of the County of Guernesey, and State of Ohio, the receipt whereof we do hereby acknowledge, have given, granted, bargained, sold, aliened, conveyed and confirmed, and by these presents do give, grant, bargain, sell, alien, convey and confirm, unto the said Harry Miskimew his heirs and assigns forever, the following premises situate in the County of Madison, in the State of Ohio, bounded and described as follows. To wit: The East half of the South East quarter of Section No. Thirteen, (13) in Township No. Seventy-six (76) North of Range No. Twenty-nine (29) West of the 5th P.M., containing Eighty acres, according to the original surveys, and situate in said Madison County, Ohio.

To have and hold the said granted premises, with all the appurtenances and privileges thereto belonging, or in any wise appertaining, or the said Harry Miskimew his heirs and assigns forever, other own proper use, benefit and behoof, as a good and indefeasible estate in fee simple, and they the said James McCoolly and Sarah Jane McCoolly, for themselves, their heirs, executors and administrators, do covenant with the said Harry Miskimew, his heirs and assigns, that before and until the sealing and delivery of these presents, they are lawfully seized in fee of the above granted premises and appurtenances, that they have good right, full power and lawful authority to sell and convey the same to Harry Miskimew, that the said premises are free from all incumbrances whatsoever, and that they do and will warrant and defend the same unto the said Harry Miskimew, his heirs and assigns forever, against the lawful claims of all persons whatsoever.
