 Iowa do hereby **Sell and Convey**, unto the said Charles A. Gaskill

the following described premises, situate in the County of Madison, and State of Iowa, to-wit:

The Undivided two thirds "2/3" of Lot Six "6" in Block  
 Ten "10" Original Town Plat of Winterset Iowa.

And we hereby covenant with the said Charles A. Gaskill that we hold said premises by good and perfect title, that we have good, right, and lawful authority, to sell and convey the same: that they are free, and clear of all liens and incumbrances whatsoever.
