**Know all Men by these Presents,** That we Thomas K. Mohler

 of Madison County and State of Iowa in consideration of the sum of  
 Fifty Dollars, in hand paid, by  
 Charlotte Mohler of Madison County, and State of  
 Iowa do hereby **Sell and Convey**, unto the said Charlotte Mohler

the following described premises, situate in the County of Madison, and State of Iowa, to-wit:  
 Commencing Fifty two "52" Rods South of the North East corner  
 of the North West fourth of the North East quarter of the South West  
 quarter of Section Thirty five "35" Township "77" Range Twenty seven "27"  
 thence West Thirty "30" Rods, thence North Twelve "12" rods, thence  
 East thirty "30" rods, thence South twelve "12" rods, to the place of  
 beginning, containing Two and one quarter acres more or less.
