**Know all Men by these Presents,** That we James J. Johnston and Mary Ann Johnston of Madison County and State of Iowa in consideration of the sum of One Thousand <sup>100</sup> Dollars, in hand paid, by Simeon Hamlin and Josephus Hamlin of Madison County, and State of Iowa do hereby **Sell and Convey**, unto the said Simeon Hamlin and Josephus Hamlin the following described premises, situate in the County of Madison, and State of Iowa, to-wit: The South half of the North East quarter, and the North half of the South East quarter of Section Number Eighteen '18", And the East half of the North West quarter of the South West quarter of the South East quarter of Section Number Eight "8" all in Township number Seventy-four "74" North of Range number "28" Twenty eight West 5<sup>th</sup> P. M. Containing One hundred and sixty five acres more or less. And we hereby covenant with the said Simeon Hamlin and Josephus Hamlin that we hold said premises by good and perfect title, that we have good, right, and lawful authority, to sell and convey the same: that they are free, and clear of all liens and incumbrances whatsoever. And we covenant to warrant and defend the said premises against the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever; and the said Mary Ann Johnston hereby relinquishes her right of dower in and to the above described premises.
