do hereby sell and convey unto Edward R. White of Peoria County and  
State of Illinois the following described premises, to-wit; The East half  
of the South West quarter of section numbered Twenty three (23) in Town-  
ship numbered Seventy seven (77) North of Range numbered Twenty nine  
(29) West, containing Eighty Acres more or less being in Madison County  
and State of Iowa, And we do hereby covenant to warrant and defend  
the said premises against the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever,  
and the said Mary wife of the said Wilson Barnett hereby relinquishes  
all her right of dower in and to the above described premises.
