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Whereas at a Meeting of the Board of Township Supervisors of Madison County Iowa, held October 16th A.D. 1865 among other proceedings had which appear of Record in the Clerk's Office in said County were the following to-wit; John A. Pitzer then made application to the Board asking them to make a Quit Claim Deed to him for lots Five, Six & Seven "5, 6 & 7" in Block No. Ten "10" in the Original Town Plat of Winterset, The Board being satisfied that the County has received full compensation for the same, and if ever deeded, that the deed is lost, It is therefore resolved that the Clerk be and he is hereby authorized to make and execute to the said John A. Pitzer a good and sufficient Quit Claim Deed for said Lots above described on behalf of the Board. Now therefore know all Men by these presents that I, Miller R. Yidrick Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in consideration of the premises and the authority placed in me as aforesaid on behalf of said County, do hereby remise, release and forever quit claim unto the said John A. Pitzer all the title, interest and estate, legal and equitable of said Madison County in the following premises, with the appurtenances, to-wit; Lots Five, Six and Seven "5, 6 & 7" in Block ^{number} Ten "10" in the Original Town Plat of the Winterset Madison County Iowa.
