 Maxwell McCants & Agatha McCants
 husband & wife, of Clark County, State of

Iowa, in consideration of the sum of Six hundred dollars, in hand
 paid, do hereby sell and convey unto William Abernathy of Park County
 and State of Indiana, the following described premises to-wit; South
 West quarter $\frac{1}{4}$ of the North West quarter $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section Thirty six "36"
 And also the East half $\frac{1}{2}$ of the North West quarter $\frac{1}{4}$ of the South West
 quarter $\frac{1}{4}$ Section Thirty six, all in Township Seventy four "74" Range
 Twenty eight "28" containing in all Sixty Acres more or less, and we do
 hereby covenant with the said William Abernathy that we are lawfully seized
 in fee simple of said premises, that they are free from Incumbrance, that we have
 good right and lawful authority to sell the same; and we do hereby covenant to warrant
 and defend the said premises and appurtenances thereto belonging against the lawful
 claims of all persons whomsoever; and the said Agatha McCants hereby relinquishes
 all her right of dower in and to the above described premises.
