Amberg and Sarah Amberg his wife of Black Hawk, in the County of Gilpin, and Territory of Colorado parties of the first part, and Otto Bruett of the same place, of the second part, Witnesseth, That the said parties of the first, in consideration of the sum of Two Thousand dollars, to them duly paid, have sold, and by these presents do grant and convey to the party of the second part his heirs and assigns, the following described property, situate, lying, and being in the County of Madison and State of Iowa, to-wit; The East half "1/2" of the South West quarter of Section number Twelve "12" and the South West quarter of the South East quarter of Section number Twelve "12" and the North East quarter of Section number Fourteen "14" all in Township number Seventy six "76" North of Range number Twenty nine "29" in the Township of Winterset, County & State aforesaid, with the appurtenances, and all the Estate, title and Interest, therein of the said parties of the first part, And the said Louis Amberg and Sarah Amberg parties of the first part do hereby covenant and agree to and with the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns that the said premises thus conveyed, in the quiet and peaceable possession of the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns they will forever warrant and defend against any person whomsoever claiming the same or any part thereof.
